One way to finance a doctorate program, next to working as a research assistant at TH Köln – University of Applied Sciences, is to apply for a doctoral or a research scholarship. Scholarships of the Fritz Thyssen Foundation are instruments used to support highly qualified individual junior scholars which have doctoral degrees in a research project over a limited period of time. They are offered to give the doctoral candidates the opportunity to fully concentrate on the research project they have selected with the help of a post-doc scholar. Research scholarships are assigned for young talented students of sectors like humanities, social sciences as well as medicine. The funding primarily takes place in Germany, whereby the promotion of international scientific work is ranked as one further goal of Fritz Thyssen Foundation.
