**Crime prevention through urban design and Planning** Role of the police in design and planning in Lower Saxony

Political objectives of the state government in 2003:

Starting point: Speach of the prime minister in Lower Saxony "...take crime prevention aspects more strengthened into account!"

Order to the police – First contact to the municipal crime prevention advisory bord

Implementation of crime prevention aspects of the police into a local process

Small scaled crime analysis

#### Analyses of different space oriented Offences and physical / social Incivilities

Qualitative assessment of the dots

- Burglary including housbreaking, bicycle theft
- Vandalism and Graffiti
- Drug using and drug dealing
- Serious crime such as murder, bodily injury, rape, robbery





## **Problem analysis**

Grafiti / Tags / Incivilities



- Problem is less the so called "professional sprayer" than the variety of individual perpetrators.
- Probelm is relevant to house walls outside the residental area, which are close to footbath, out of social controlled and not well lighted
- Cost of damages are dependent upon cleaning effort open.pored surface
- Placers where people feel unsafe







# Problem analysis

Mobility

- No transit traffic expected in residential area; moderate traffic load inside the area in total.
- Responsible and concerted use of different mobility forms (pedestrians, cycliost and cars) is important for an efficient neighbourhoos
- Problem with stationary traffic, parking space
